Executive Summary

The Board of Supervisors appoints three at-large representatives of the general community to the Santa Cruz Metropolitan Transit District Board of Directors. Due to the resignation of Mike Rotkin, a vacancy exists for one of these positions.

Discussion

Pursuant to policy adopted by the Board of Supervisors in 1995, of the three individuals appointed to these positions, at least one appointee must be a person who lives with a disability and uses public transportation as their primary means of transportation. Two of the Board's current appointees represent the general community and do not meet the criteria just outlined. Accordingly, the individual appointed to fill this vacancy must be a person who lives with a disability and uses public transportation as their primary means of transportation. The Board can accept this memo as notification of this vacancy, with nominations for appointment to be received on June 24, 2025, and final appointment to be considered on August 5, 2025.
