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To the Board of Supervisors.

I oppose the roads list in the 2025 Pavement management project plan!

There is a clear inequitable preference of suburban roads in relatively fair condition. There needs to be at-least some representation of the imperiled mountain and rural roads.

While there indeed are some major and in-need roads listed, there are too many seemingly fair condition dead-end and/or lightly used residential roads fit in the list. All of the listed are exclusively in the flat suburban areas. It gives an impression that political favors may be deciding the roads picked over need. The mountain roads are completely ignored. Our mountain roads have significant slopes and hydrology conditions that make them far more deserving, or else more destructive and expensive to neglect.

Last year Stetson Rd, was promised some very minimal paving but cancelled. While I nominate Stetson to go on the list, I'd like to see any of many deserving rural mountain roads be included.
