I am writing to urge you to DENY the proposed cell tower installation on Summit Drive.

Scientific evidence and community concern insist on the need for considered caution regarding the placement of wireless infrastructure, especially near homes, schools, and playgrounds. The long-term effects of this radiation are not fully understood, and it is simply not right to impose this risk on our most vulnerable residents when viable alternatives exist.

There is no demonstrated coverage gap in this area, and the alternative site at Patrick Road would not place this burden directly on families with small children.
