2025 PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROJECT

This project involves the construction of: **pavement grinding, digouts, asphalt concrete leveling courses and overlays, rubberized cape seals, rubber chip SAMIs (stress absorbing membrane interlayers), microsurfacing seals, full-depth recycling, striping, pavement markings, and raising iron (utilities and monuments).**

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond. The Contractor shall possess a Class **A or C-12** license at the time that this contract is awarded. The Department of Public Works hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, gender, or national origin in consideration for an award.
