Recommended Actions

Approve appointment of Jillian Ritter as the Alternate Director representing the County on the Santa Cruz Mid-County Groundwater Agency Board of Directors.

Executive Summary

The County has two seats on the Board of Directors of the Santa Cruz Mid-County Groundwater Agency. Pursuant to the Joint Power Agreement for this Agency, the County also has one Alternate that can serve on the board in the absence of one or both of the County board members. The prior Alternate, Shane Mckeithen, has stepped down from this position, therefore it is necessary to appoint a new Alternate.

Discussion

On February 23, 2016, our Board approved a Joint Powers Agreement with the City of Santa Cruz, Soquel Creek Water District, and Central Water District to form the Santa Cruz Mid-County Groundwater Agency. Our Board appointed the two Supervisors whose districts overlap the groundwater basin to serve on the Board of Directors for this Agency—the District 1 Supervisor and the District 2 Supervisor. Pursuant to the JPA, the County also has one Alternate that can serve on the board in the absence of one or both of the County board members.

It is recommended that the Board appoint Jillian Ritter as the Alternate representing the County on the Santa Cruz Mid-County Groundwater Agency Board of Directors.
