RESOLUTION SETTING HEARING ON PROPOSED SERVICE CHARGE
REPORTS FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA 48 – COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined the nature, extent, and cost of the extended services to be provided within the County Service Area Number 48 – County Fire for the 2025/26 fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the County will prepare reports apportioning the total cost of such extended services to parcels within the above County Service Area in proportion to the estimated benefits to be received by each parcel;

WHEREAS, on or before June 10, 2025, said service charge reports will be placed on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors that Tuesday, June 24, 2025, during the morning agenda, in the Board Chambers, Room 525, County Governmental Center, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California, the Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on the benefit assessment/service charge reports of benefit assessments/service charges within County Service Area Number 48 for the 2025/26 fiscal year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that at the time, date, and place above, the Board of Supervisors shall hear all objections or protests, if any, to the reports.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall cause notice of the filing of the reports and the time, date, and place of hearing, to be published once a week for two successive weeks prior to the date set for hearing, in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Santa Cruz County, pursuant to Government Code Section 6066 and County Code Section 4.26.


