**Subject: Complaint about Alleged Corruption within Santa Cruz County.**

Dear Board of Supervisors,

I am asking to attach my letter to BOS Agenda for meeting on 03/25/2025. I hope this letter finds you in good health and high spirits. My family is not in good health and is not in good spirits for a decade, because of deep corruption built up by Behavioral Health Division County employees and ongoing no accountability against their unfair practices by abuse of power, mistreatment, mismanagement, misdiagnosis, discrimination and retaliation at all. The BHD doctors are under the Oath to Hippocrates in addition to Oath to Office that they sign with Santa Cruz County and easily violate both without any fear. My daughter gets assigned doctors who never intended to do their job for her wellbeing and safety. Also, for a decade, my daughter gets assigned unlicensed, so-called Mental Health Client Specialists who never intended, not capable, incompetent, unqualified to do their job for her wellbeing and safety. No one single BHD county employee was investigated during a decade of my ongoing allegations based on undeniable facts. It is obviously that hiring process assessments for important assignments on highly paid positions under SCC Health Service Agency continue do not involve a required level of education, professionalism, competence and ethics to satisfy the top of the priority for wellbeing and safety incapable to protect herself member of the community, my teenager's mentality daughter, instead followed the private own purpose to build up the power abuse to protect their intentional, knowledgeable and willful neglect of the person's health and life. There is obviously no understanding of the responsibility, important job duty and consequences of violation of Oath to Office. I am writing to express my deep concern and dissatisfaction regarding the alleged instances of corruption within Santa Cruz County. As a concerned citizen and

taxpayer, I believe it is my duty to bring these matters to your attention before my family get murdered by criminal syndicate that target my family.

Over the past decade, there have been hundreds my written reports submitted to BOS and rumors circulating among the public about corrupt practices within your agency Behavioral Health Division (BHD) under Health Service Agency (HSA) that covered up by the Quality Improvements Department (QID). Unfortunately, QID does not follow its purpose to supervise the Quality of Health Services in Santa Cruz County and exist to covering up all illegal and unfair practices that led to establish untouchable, above the law criminal syndicate. These allegations range from embezzlement of public funds to bribery and nepotism. Such true and constant allegations for a decade never were allowed to be investigated by the County Administration, and not only tarnish the reputation of Santa Cruz County, but also erode the trust of the public in our government institutions.

I urge you to conduct a thorough and impartial investigation into these allegations to ascertain their veracity. It is crucial that the investigation is transparent and conducted by an independent body to ensure fairness and impartiality. Additionally, I request that the findings of the investigation be made public to restore faith in the integrity of Santa Cruz County Government.

Corruption not only undermines the effectiveness of government agencies but also hinders the progress and development of our nation. It is our collective responsibility to eliminate corruption and uphold the principles of transparency, accountability, and good governance.

I believe that some county agency has the power and responsibility to address this issue promptly and effectively. I kindly request that you keep me informed about the progress of the investigation and any actions taken to address the alleged corruption within Behavioral Health Division.

I appreciate your attention to this matter and hope that the outcome of the investigation will reaffirm our faith in the integrity of our government institutions.
