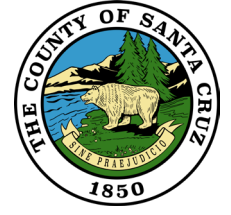

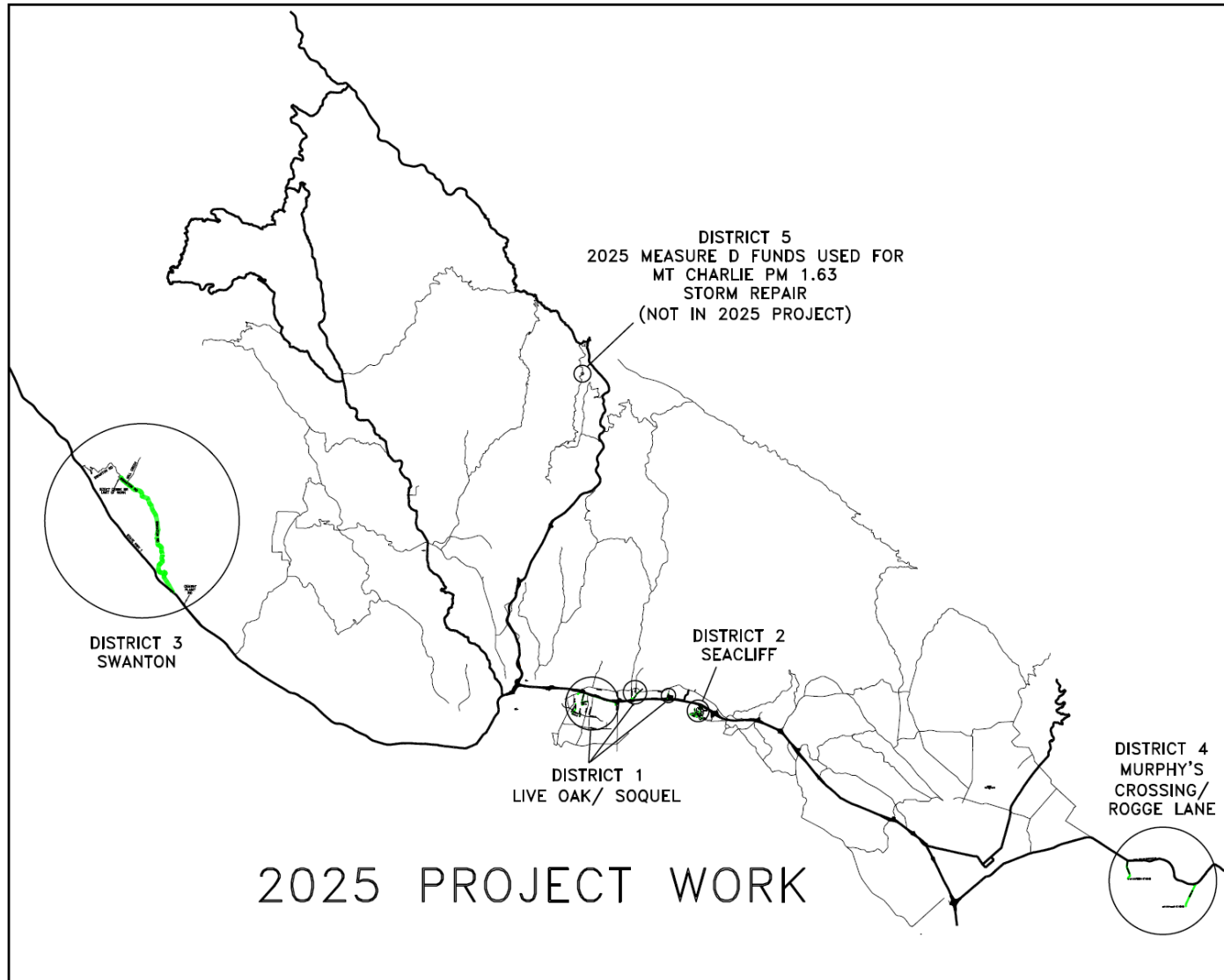

Project Funding Overview

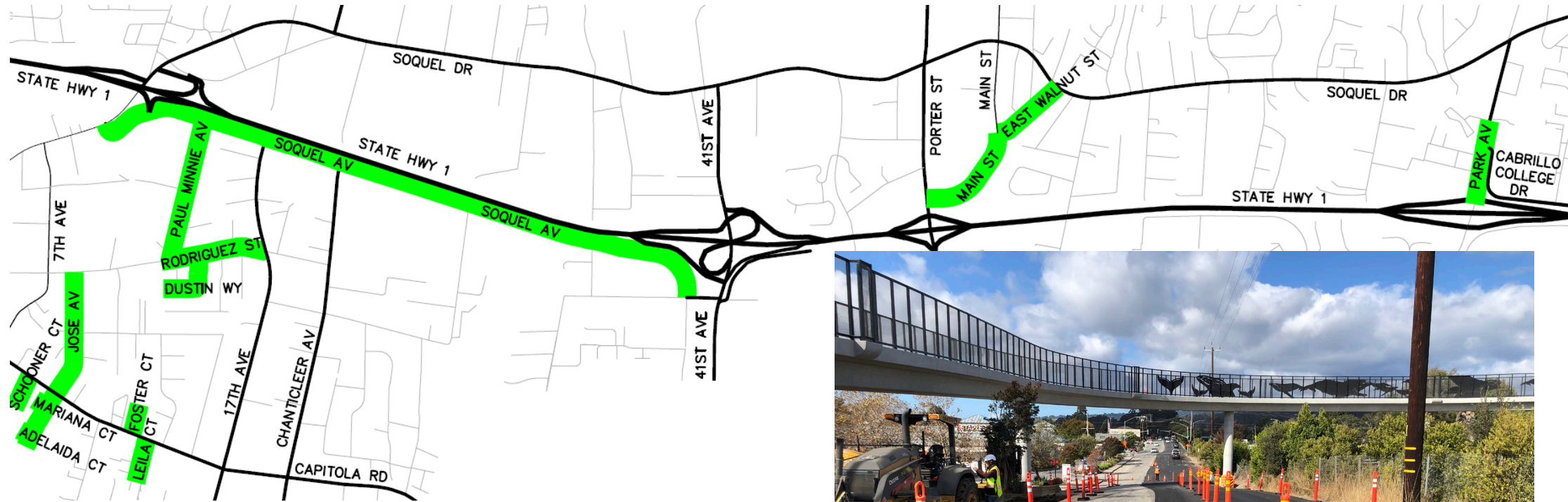
- **This project leverages several funding sources to provide a robust paving project for the 2025 season. Integrating multiple sources of similar work into a single project increases bid competition and lowers the overall cost of the work.**
- **Largely funded by Measure D, the first funding source primarily dedicated to local road paving. CDI has put out pavement management projects funded by Measure D every year since 2018.**
- **RSTP Grant funded roadways included in this project. Measure D used as local match for grant funds.**
- **CDI also partnering with County Parks and County Sanitation to integrate some of their paving work into this project.**

Live Oak/ Soquel



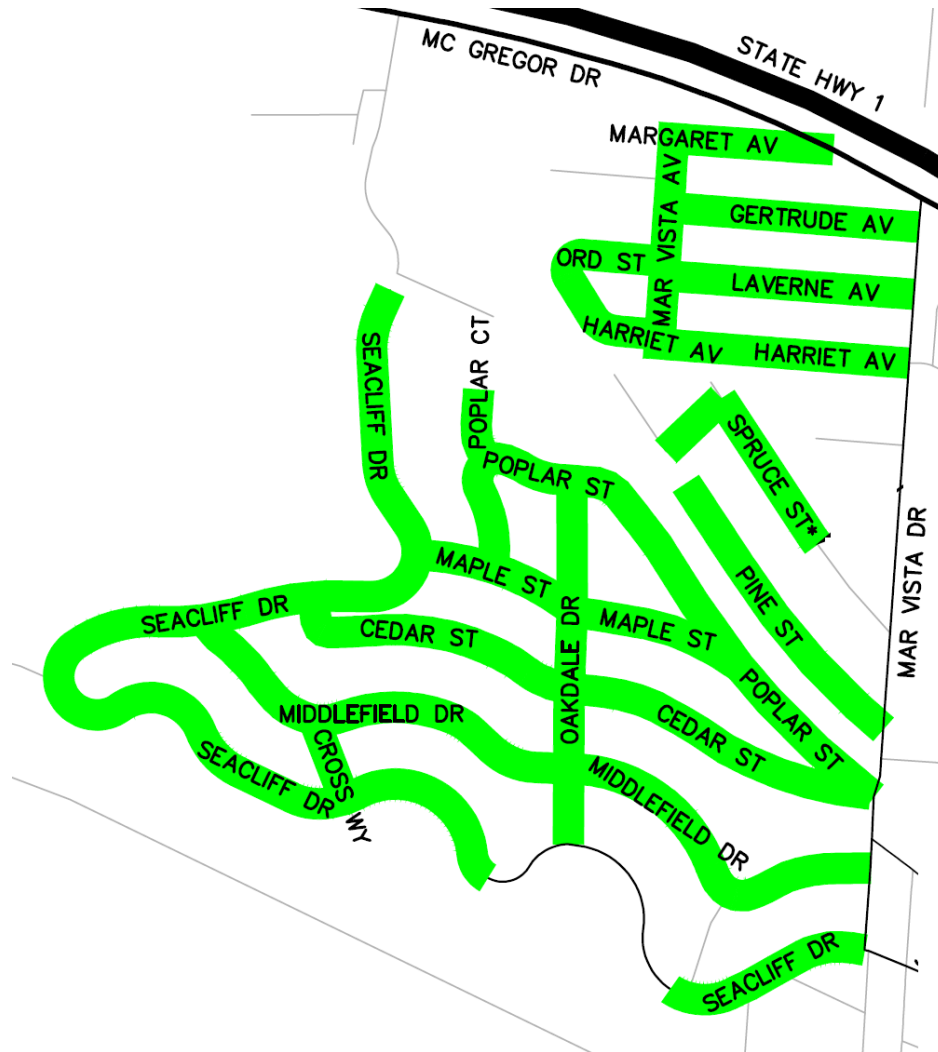
Summer 2025 Work:

- Focus on Pure Water Project streets and neighborhood streets in Live Oak area.
- Work to include Base Repairs, Roadway Sealing, and Green Bike Lane Enhancements

West Seacliff

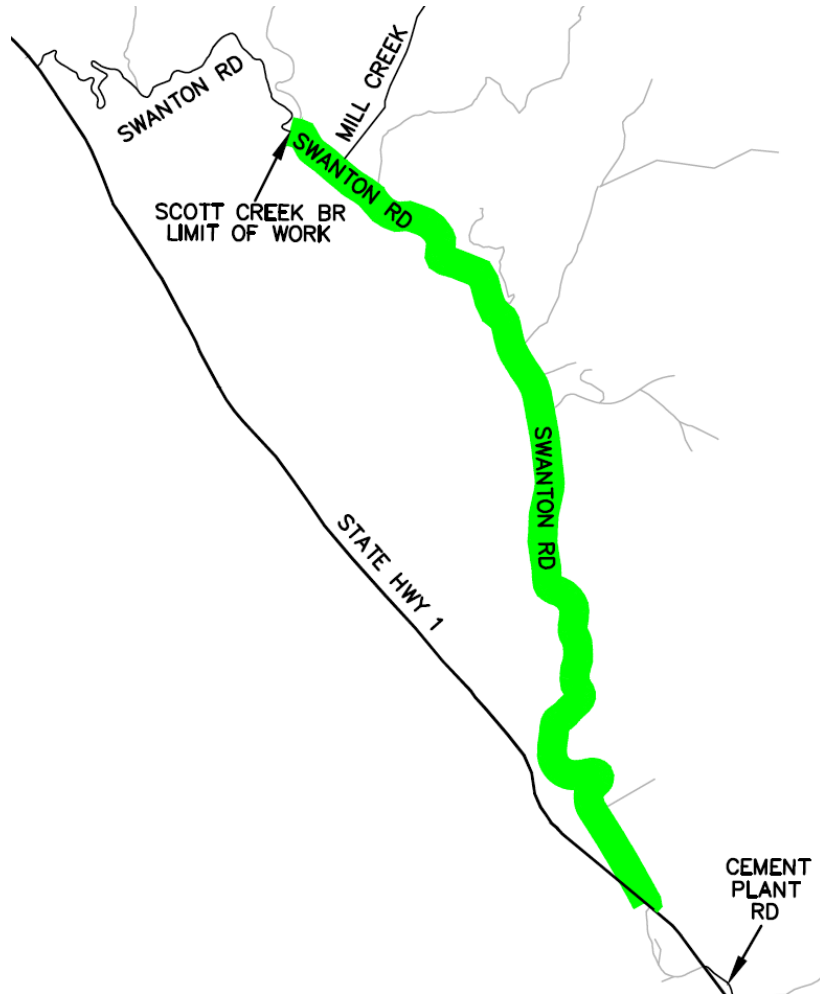


Summer 2025 Work:

- **Partnership with County Sanitation, Roads will perform pavement restoration on streets affected by Sanitation Project with Sanitation Funds. Surrounding streets to be resurfaced with Measure D Funds.**
- **Work includes Base Repairs, Cape Seals, Overlays, & Restriping**

Swanton Rd

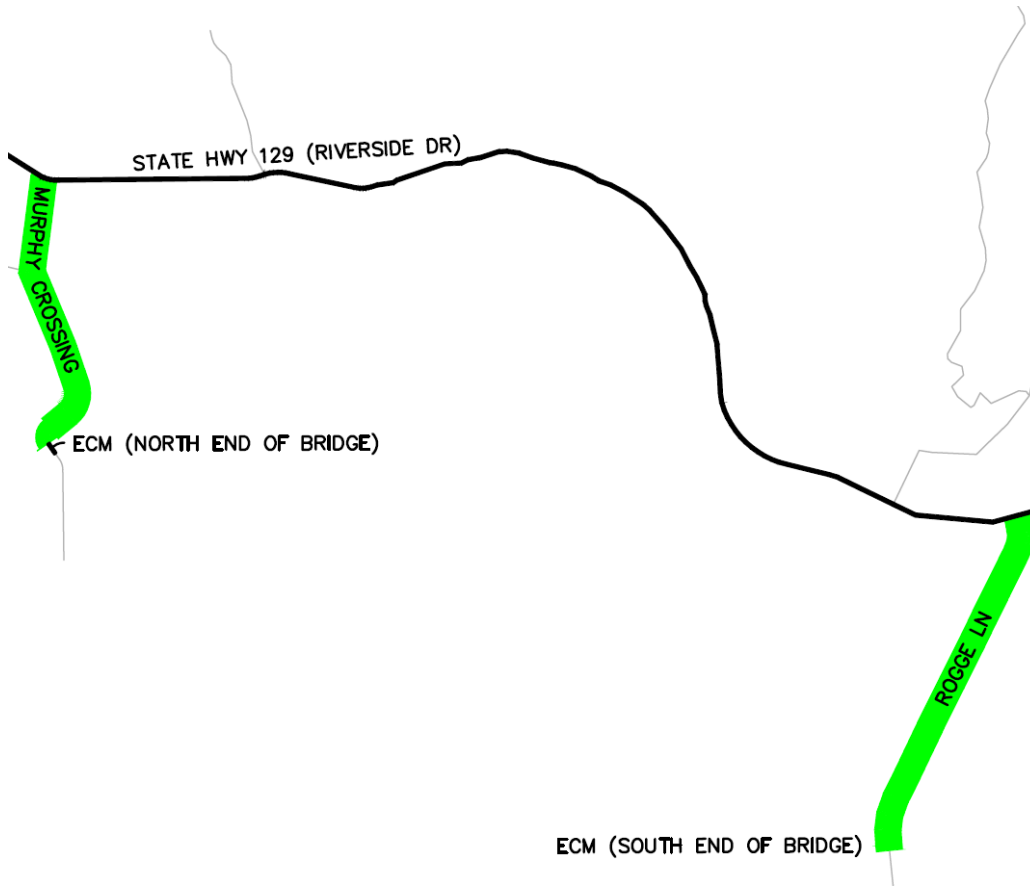


Summer 2025 Work:

- Large Project on Swanton Rd (4.5 miles).
- District 3 has been reserving Measure D funding for this project since 2019.
- Work includes Asphalt Paving & Restriping

Murphy's Crossing & Rogge Lane

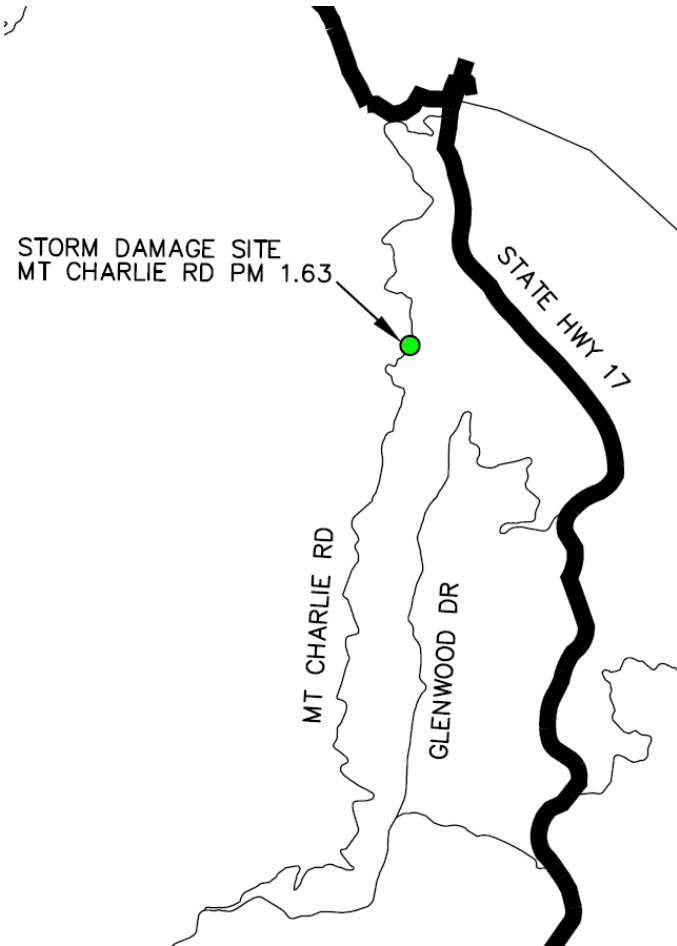


Summer 2025 Work:

- **Primary funding from "InterCounty Routes" RSTP Grant with Measure D as local match.**
- **Work to include Full Depth Recycling, Paving, Striping**

Summer 2025 Work:

- **Resurfacing of Moran Lake Parking Lot (Funding Provided by Parks)**

Recommended Actions

- 1. Approve the specifications, engineer's estimate, and authorize call for bids for the 2025 Pavement Management Project;**
- 2. Set bid opening for 2:15 p.m. on March 6, 2025;**
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Notice to Contractors for ten days beginning February 15, 2025, per the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392;**
- 4. Authorize the Deputy CAO/Director of Community Development and Infrastructure to award and sign the contract with the qualified low bidder;**
- 5. Direct Community Development and Infrastructure to return on or before June 24, 2025, for ratification of the contract award;**
- 6. Approve a transfer of funds in the amount of \$1,781,000 from the Measure D account for the 2025 Pavement Management project; and**
- 7. Approve a transfer of funds in the amount of \$1,035,000 from the InterCounty Routes RSTPX Grant Fund account for the 2025 Pavement Management project.**
