As a long term Scotts Valley resident, I oppose "The Haven"- a 157 unit development, on a 40 acre Sandhills site by Henry Cowell Redwoods State Park!

We do not want a Sandhills habitat & puma corridor destroyed for a high-density development that will decimate endangered species, strain the already limited water supply, lengthen daily commutes, increase traffic risk, & impede fire evacuations - all for a few "affordable in name only" housing units. We've already been part of the evac for CZU fire and with these additional units it would cost lives of families and emergency responders as people couldn't get out or in.

This area has no walkability or transit line; & the fire insurance, in this high-risk zone, would be considerable. We do not think sacrificing 600 trees for 600 parking spaces is a good trade for Santa Cruz County!

Our family votes NO!
