Executive Summary

Government Code Section 53607 requires the County Treasurer to submit a monthly report of investment transactions to the Board of Supervisors.

Discussion

The Santa Cruz County Investment Pool ("the Pool") is a local government fund which ranges in size from \$1 billion to over \$1.6 billion dollars on an annual basis. The Pool is comprised of monies deposited by ten public school districts servicing over 40,000 students from grades K-12, Cabrillo College, cities, public agencies, and special districts located within Santa Cruz County, and the County itself. The largest external pool members are county schools, Santa Cruz County Fire Districts, Santa Cruz Metro, and other transportation agencies. Over recent years, Pool assets have gradually increased due to rising tax collections and increased bond proceeds. Per California code 53600.5, Safety of assets should be the primary objective when investing. Liquidity should be the subordinate goal and Yield should always be the last objective.

There were \$111 million in purchases and deposits and \$185 million in redemptions and withdrawals in the investment pool for the month of January 2025. The average balance of the investment pool for the month of January 2025 was \$1.5 billion.
