Executive Summary

To support the functions of the County of Santa Cruz Flood Control and Water Conservation District Zone 7, it is necessary that your Board appoint non-voting representatives nominated by the Second and Fourth Supervisorial Districts to the Zone 7 Board.

Discussion

In conformance with the Rules and Regulations of Zone 7, there shall be two non-voting Zone 7 Board members nominated by the Second and Fourth Supervisorial Districts and approved by the County of Santa Cruz Board of Supervisors. Pursuant to Section 1.9, (J), of the Rules and Regulations of Zone 7, the non-voting members shall live within the boundaries of Zone 7 and can initiate and participate in board items and discussions in an advisory capacity. Non-voting members may not initiate motions, second motions, vote on motions, or participate in or attend closed Zone 7 Board sessions.
